About Kaohsiung Medical University

Originally known as "Kaohsiung Medical College"-the first private medical institution in Taiwan, Kaohsiung Medical University was founded in 1954 by former Kaohsiung Mayor Frank C. Chen, who donated land for the college site, and Professor Tsung Ming Tu, the first Taiwanese ever to earn a MD degree. In response to the needs for clinical teaching, research and internships, the College's affiliated Chung-Ho Memorial Hospital, a teaching hospital and medical center, was founded in 1957. In 1998, the College signed an agreement with the Kaohsiung Municipal Government, allowing it to assume managing Kaohsiung Municipal Hsiao-Kang Hospital. After Kaohsiung Medical College became a university in 1999, it seized this opportunity to move faster and attain to the highest standards in teaching, research, medical care and service; hence it expanded the territory of medical services further by obtaining the right of management of Kaohsiung Municipal Ta-Tung Hospital, a regional teaching hospital, in 2010.

Since its founding, Kaohsiung Medical University is sparing no effort in keeping pace with international development and following its motto of "Enjoying learning, prioritizing research.", and "Resolutely striving for progress, encouraging study, and contributing to the world.", at the same time. The current president Dr. Ching-Kuan Liu, who took office in 2012, specifically proposed a management philosophy of "I Love KMU-Innovation, Legislation, Knowledge, Mission, Universality" with "Respect for life, the pursuit of truth" as the core value to nurture interdisciplinary health professionals who practice unity of learning and using as well as unity of research and using, in the hope of raising the University' status as one of leading medical universities with international competitive strength.

The University consists of 7 colleges, 21 departments (including postgraduate and PhD programs), 4 resource integration centers and 5 graduate institutes. In addition, the General Education Center offers courses on arts, literature, history, politics, etc. and hosts a number of cultural activities to cultivate students' comprehensive mind, humanistic literacy, and diverse competence, hence to bring up students with care for the human society, expansive global view, and lifelong learning ability, in order to achieve the goal of holistic education.

The University attaches importance to international exchanges and cooperation to develop students' international perspective. So far, it has established academic ties with 45 sister institutions, including University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences, Harvard University Medical School and School of Public Health, University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill



School of Pharmacy and the School of Nursing, University of Pennsylvania School of Dental Medicine, Medical University of South Africa, University of Georgia College of Public Health, University of Nagasaki, Kyushu University, George Mason University, Seoul National University, Hebrew University of Jerusalem Faculty of Medicine, etc. Each year, for implementing the above cooperation agreements, visits and exchange activities are organized, and international academic conferences and seminars are held to promote international academic exchanges.

The shared vision of everyone at KMU is to make the university a modern, forward-looking institution striving for excellence in both academics and medical care. After its first half-century, it has become Southern Taiwan's foremost center for medical education and services and has repetitively received ratings of "superior" in all categories after evaluation under the Ministry of Education's evaluation of "Mid-term School Administration Development Plan". Other remarkable honors include:

- 1. All departments and graduate institutes (44 programs) were accredited by Higher Education and Accreditation Council of Taiwan in 2009.
- 2. The University passed the University Evaluation conducted by Higher Education Evaluation & Accreditation Council of Taiwan in 2011.
- 3. The University has been granted funding for "Plan to Encourage Teaching Excellence in Universities" 6 times by the Ministry of Education during 2005-2012.

A Program Objectives

The aim of the Bachelor Program in Medical Laboratory Science and Biotechnology is to provide undergraduate students a wide area of education in clinical laboratory technology and biomedical sciences. This degree integrates a complex level of theoretical and technical instruction in laboratories

B • Curriculum Design and Requirements for Graduation

a. Design Principle and Feature

1. Principle:

The curriculum is designed to provide students a wide area of education in clinical laboratory technology and biomedical sciences. This degree integrates a complex level of theoretical and technical instruction in laboratories.

2. Feature:

The curriculum emphasizes in the area of Biomedicine, Molecular Biotechnology, and Laboratory Science.



1. Biomedicine: Microbiology, immunology, blood and blood bank,



biochemistry, anatomy, physiology, biochemistry...etc are included and also the mainstream in the field of Biomedicine. In recent years, innovation and science development have created a new era of human intractable diseases.

- 2. Medical Laboratory Science: Medical Laboratory science contains clinical biochemistry, clinical serology and immunology, hematology and blood bank examination, clinical microscopy science, microbiology examination, toxic substance detection, detection of heavy metals and environmental biomedical monitoring line ...etc. Nowadays, with the modernization of the medical field and the new clinical knowledge, detection of macro sample has transferred to micro sample, which increase the sensitivity and specificity.
- Molecular biology: molecular biological technology is the base of Biomedicine and Medical Laboratory Science. In recent years, it has become one of the important mainstreams in biomedicine field.

C 、 Curriculum Structure

We expect to cooperate with the allies through academic and technical collaboration to help train the high school graduates to become experts in the field of medical laboratory science and biotechnology, and awarded them the Bachelor of Science degree if only they complete 128 credits of the program.

Curriculum design: Combining the experienced teaching faculty, which includes faculty members from Department of Medical Laboratory Science and Biotechnology, School of Medicine, Department of Medicinal and Applied Chemistry, Department of Biomedical Science and Environmental Biology, Center for General Education, and Division of Physical Education, with the sophisticated clinical faculty of KMUH to establish the Curriculum Planning Committee discussing about the curriculum for different professions through meetings, and award the graduates with Bachelor of Science degree. Courses designed will be focused in skills and knowledge. (F-2)



- 1. During the first three years, the students are enrolled in general education, science, and preliminary medical technology courses.
- 2. During the final year, students are required to stay 20 weeks in hospitals for clinical practice in the final year which train students to have the core value.

Administrative Guides for International Applicants

Article I : Number of Recruits

The Kaohsiung Medical University (KMU) is recruiting international students, who will take the courses alone or with domestic students of the curriculum. All courses are instructed in English. We will recruit 10-20 undergraduate students in the future.

Article II: Source of Funding for the Scholarship

This scholarship program designed for international students is funded by the ICDF and other public or private funding sources. Please check the website of ICDF scholarship:

Article III: Admission Requirement

Please see Attachment 1 for the related regulations of the KMU regarding international student admission. Enrollment is subject to be reviewed by the Bachelor Program in biotechnology. Besides the entrance qualification, applicants must have taken a minimum of 2 courses of Biology and Chemistry, and good standing in academic achievement.

For those whose native language is not English must present evidence of English language proficiency equivalent to TOEFL ITP score of 500 or above. Applicants who are recommended by the embassies of the R.O.C. Ministry of Foreign Affairs, the ICDF, or other related institutions will receive a preferential consideration at the reviewing process.

Article IV : Program Duration

According to the policy of the ICDF scholarship that the duration of financial support is limited to four years for Bachelor's program. The scholarship provided by the ICDF shall not extend beyond the stipulated time period. Those who have completed all the required courses may continue to complete the thesis with other funding sources upon the approval of one's national government, the R.O.C. Ministry of Foreign Affairs, and ICDF.



Article V : Deadline for Application

All completed application materials must be received by the KMU through the R.O.C. Deadline will change by every year and no later than April 10th of each year. Article VI : Required Documents

The following items must be submitted with the application when applying to the KMU.

- 1. Two copies of the completed application form (Appendix 1)
- 2. An official transcript and the highest-level diploma verified by R.O.C representative office. (Chinese or English translation is required if the transcript is in neither of the languages aforementioned.)
- 3. Financial statement that shows financial sustainability for study in Taiwan, proof of the scholarship provided by a government agency, university, college, or private organization, or KMU scholarship for International Students Application Form.

a. The bank statement shall be issued by the bank officially with the information of current balance and currency, and be authenticated by R.O.C. representative office in/near your country, or sealed and mailed to KMU by your bank directly.

b. Financial statements from a Taiwanese bank or a branch of a foreign bank located in Taiwan do not need to be authenticated.

- 4. A statement of purpose in English which shall include the following:
 - (1) Purpose of study— Delineating the reasons for studying in Taiwan.
 - (2) Autobiography—Stating the applicant's background, personal interest, strengths and weakness, if any.
 - (3) Plans of study— Stating specific area of interest and proposed subject of current or future research objectives.
 - (4) Anticipated results—Stating how the study in Taiwan will facilitate the achievement of personal and scientific goals.
- 5. Two letters of recommendation.
- An English proficiency test score equivalent to one of the followings or above for those whose native or official language is not English: TOEFL ITP 500, CBT 173, iBT 61, IELTS 4.5 or TOEIC 600.
- 7. According to regulations of the Ministry of Education and the Ministry of the Interior, the applicants must submit their birth certificates, certifications of the parents and any document that shows their parental relationships, as well as the documents that certify the applicant's nationality.

9. Application Checklist (Appendix 3)(Incomplete applications will not be reviewed.)

Please submit your completed application form with the required documents via post to the Division of Admission Affairs, Office of Academic Affairs, Kaohsiung Medical University, 100 Shi-Chuan 1st Rd., Kaohsiung, 80708, Taiwan, R.O.C. prior to the application closing date. Please state "For International Students Admissions" on the envelope.

No application with missing articles or incomplete forms will be accepted by the Kaohsiung Medical University. No late submission or any make-up practice will be accepted.

Article VII : Important Admissions Reminders

- According to the Ministry of Education regulations, if you have ever been expelled by any university or college in Taiwan under these circumstances (with drop-out records due to failure in conduct grades, academic grades, or being indicted guilty by the criminal law), you are not allowed to apply to this university. Violation of this regulation will result in the denial of admission regardless of the merits of the application.
- 2. If foreign students apply for the initial household registration in Taiwan R.O.C. or acquire naturalization or restoration of Taiwan Nationality during their period of study, their status of foreign students will be denied and their student status will be discontinued.
- 3. No double identities (overseas compatriot students and international students): Individuals should decide with which status they wish to apply from the very beginning, as the rules are strict and there are no exceptions. Those who study in Taiwan with double identities (overseas compatriot and international student) will have their recognized student status revoked.
- 4. When enrolling in any of the programs, international students are required to provide health care & injury insurance, National Health Insurance, or any other insurance related documents. KMU provides insurance application assistance to those who are not insured; insurance payment should be made upon registration.
- 5. Admitted applicants, who arrived after the 1st semester had started for one-third of the term, are not permitted to enroll in that semester. Graduate students are allowed to enroll for the second semester with the approval of the dean of their faculty or graduate institute.



- 6. KMU offers a free and short-term intensive Chinese course during the summer. Students are responsible for their living expenses, accommodation and visa fee.
- 7. For all other related information, please refer to the MOE Regulations Regarding International Students Undertaking Studies in Taiwan, International Student Recruitment Regulations of KMU, and other relevant rules.
- 8. No application documents would be returned for any reason. Please make copies for yourself if needed.
- 9. The title of the awards granted by each department or institute would follow the format announced by the Ministry of Education.

Article VIII : Others

In the event of issues or matters not mentioned in the preceding articles, pertinent rules and regulations of the R.O.C. Ministry of Education and Kaohsiung Medical University shall apply.



Attachment 1. Kaohsiung Medical University Foreign Students Admission Regulation

Nationality

The international applicants are not the citizens of Taiwan, R.O.C. nor overseas Chinese. The applicant who meets the following requirements and have lived overseas for more than six years (or more than eight years if they are applying for undergraduate programs in Medicine, Dentistry or Chinese Medicine) and lived in Taiwan for less than 120 days per year are qualified for admissions:

- ① The applicant with Taiwan, R.O.C. nationality has never registered in a permanent address in Taiwan while applying for the program.
- ⁽²⁾ The applicant once held the Taiwanese citizenship but has ceased the status for more than 8 years since the renunciation was issued by the Ministry of the Interior while applying for the program.
- ③ The applicant with the provisions specified with the above requirements ① and ② has never studied in Taiwan as an overseas Chinese student.
 - According to the Cultural Exchange Agreement, a foreign nationality who was selected by an overseas government, organization, school, or educational/cultural group to study in Taiwan, is not subject to the limitation as stated in the preceding requirements as long as he/she has never registered in a permanent address in Taiwan.
 - The six-year or eight-year periods as prescribed in the first paragraph shall be calculated from the date of the first date of the semester (such as February 1st or August 1st).
 - The applicant who applied for the renunciation of the Taiwan, R.O.C. nationality before February 1st, 2011 is not subject to the requirement².
 - **Note: The "overseas" Chinese excludes the citizens of China, Hong Kong and Macau.

Qualifications

Undergraduate Programs: A senior high school diploma acquired from an overseas senior high school or a foreign or bilingual school in Taiwan shall be recognized by MOE and verified by R.O.C. representative office.
